Welcome to the Master of Science programme in Occupational Therapy at the School of Health and Welfare, Jönköping University!

You will be studying towards a Degree of Master (120 credits) with a major in Occupational Therapy. You have chosen to study this programme with a 50% study pace for a duration of four academic years (August 2024 – June 2028). Part-time (50%) study pace means approximately 20 hours of studies per week.

The programme is a web-based programme that uses the online learning management system, Canvas. All programme activities – such as lectures, real-time seminars, supervisions, and examinations – are conducted online. This means that there are **no** compulsory meetings on campus. Real-time meetings are held using Zoom. Most courses have their meetings on Tuesdays.
